1 General

For fire safety reasons, only adequately certified materials may be used during events taking place at the University of Zurich, especially those situated in places that are classified as escape routes. In those places, only material that has been classified as non-flammable (classification RF1) by the VKF¹ may be used. Certificates issued in accordance with the European norm EN 13501-1:2009 can also be accepted. For temporary events it is possible to allow materials that are classified as flame resistant under the condition that a risk analysis has determined it to be safe. It is neither possible to accept certificates which have been issued in accordance with the German norm DIN 4102 (for example B1 and B2) nor the French norm NF P 92-503 (for example M1 and M2). Some manufacturers of properly certified materials are listed below. The list is not final, and no responsibility is taken for the correctness of the details provided. For additions and corrections please contact brandschutz@su.uzh.ch. In any case it is necessary to obtain the required certificates and have them ready for an inspection until the end of the event. Any questions regarding the choice of materials and fire safety at events in general may be directed at the above email address as well.

1.1 Roll-ups

The housings of roll-ups are usually made of metal (aluminium) and are considered non-flammable. For constructions purely made from metal no certificate is required. Most fabric rolls used in roll-ups are swappable, such that exhibitors that lack the proper certification for their product are able to solely buy the fabric roll itself.
